MINUTES OF ELECTION MEETING

August 24th, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Wayne Scott, the board chairperson at 10:01 am in the Shebandowan Community Centre.

Lynn Scott then asked if there were any nominations from the floor. Tracey Johnson, nominated Richard Baxter. Richard agreed to let his name stand. She asked a second time, receiving no additional nominations. She asked a third and final time, with no additional nominations received. Having received no mail-in nominations, the nominations were closed, with 6 candidates on the ballot for the 5 board positions. A secret ballot vote was then held. After the vote, Marla Michel, MENDM representative, counted the ballots, with the secretary/treasurer recording the results.
